THE PURPOSE

Disciple-Making Definition

ALLEN HADIDIAN:

"Discipling others is the process by which a Christian with a life worth emulating commits himself for an extended period of time to a few individuals who have been won to Christ, the *purpose* being to aid and guide their growth to *maturity* and to *equip* them to reproduce into a third spiritual generation."

THE PURPOSE

SEMINAR DESCRIPTION:

"The ultimate **purpose** of discipleship is to turn our disciples into disciple making reproducers who multiply their life into third and fourth generations. The <u>problem</u> is, most of us either stop after someone makes a profession of faith or some of us will even help someone learn how to study the Bible and pray but few of us actually help someone get to the point where they are able to multiply their life into another individual. Come to this seminar to learn disciple-making principles that will help us reach the world through multiplying movements of disciple-making reproducers."

Disciple-Making Definition

THE PROBLEM IS...

Most disciple-makers do not fulfill the purpose of discipleship

- The *maturity* of the disciple is overlooked (Col. 1:28-29)
- The process of <u>equipping</u> (2 Tim. 2:2) them to reproduce into a third spiritual generation is never begun.

ROBERT COLEMAN:

"Here is where we must begin just like Jesus. It will be slow, tedious, painful, and probably unnoticed by men at first, but the end result will be glorious, even if we don't live to see it. Seen this way, though, it becomes a big decision in the ministry. One must decide where he wants his ministry to count — in the momentary applause of popular recognition or in the reproduction of his life in a few chosen men who will carry on his work after he as gone. Really it is a question of which generation we are living for."

"Jesus devoted most of His remaining life on earth to these few disciples. He literally staked His whole ministry upon them....

Why? Why did Jesus deliberately concentrate His life upon comparatively so few people? Had he not come to save the world?

The answer to this question focuses at once the real purpose of His plan for evangelism. Jesus was not trying to impress the crowd, but to usher in a Kingdom. This meant that He needed **men** who could lead the multitudes. What good would it have been for His ultimate objective to arouse the masses to follow Him if these people had no subsequent supervision nor instruction in the Way?"

TRAINING LANGUAGE

- Direction Questions:
 - Where am I taking them? (Vision)
 - Where are they now? (Insight)
 - What is the next step? (Intentionality)
- 5 C's of Training
 - Conviction / Core —> Tell them why
 - Competence —> Show them <u>how</u>
 - Consistency —> Keep them going
 - Confidence —> Do it with them
 - Christlikeness —> Do it in <u>front</u> of them (model)
